Plant Something



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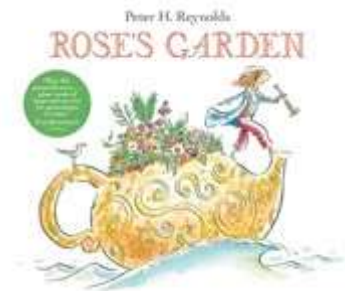
It is spring. This is when plants start to grow. **Plant** something you can eat. Growing a **salad** takes time, but it is worth the wait.
